CYNGOR GWYNEDD WELL-BEING STATEMENT 2023/24

Introduction

As a Council, we are committed to the principles within the Well-being of Future Generations (Wales) Act 2015 in order to improve the economic, social, environmental and cultural well-being of communities in Gwynedd.

We will ensure that the Council considers the long term by collaborating and considering people of all ages when resolving and preventing problems. Working in this way will enable us to meet the present needs of our communities while ensuring that today's decisions are not harmful to future generations.

We reviewed our well-being objectives as part of the process of creating the Council Plan for 2023-28. In determining our well-being objectives, we considered several sources of evidence including information from consultation sessions held with Elected Members, response to a public consultation on the proposed priorities for the Council Plan and the results of the Anglesey and Gwynedd Public Services Board Well-being Assessments published in 2022.

Our well-being objectives contribute directly to achieving the national well-being goals (as noted below) and include the practical steps or projects we will undertake in order to contribute towards the objective. These will be reviewed regularly.

The Council's Well-being Objectives (priority areas within the Council Plan)

These are the seven well-being objectives -

A society that enables people to fulfil their potential no matter what their background or circumstances (including their socio-economic background and circumstances).

A WALES OF COHESIVE COMMUNITIES

Attractive, viable, safe and well-connected communities.

A WALES OF VIBRANT CULTURE AND THRIVING WELSH LANGUAGE

A society that promotes and protects culture, heritage and the Welsh language, and which encourages people to participate in the arts, and sports and recreation.

A GLOBALLY RESPONSIBLE WALES

A nation which, when doing anything to improve the economic, social, environmental and cultural well-being of Wales, takes account of whether doing such a thing may make a positive contribution to global well-being.
