Every hackney carriage vehicle must pass a Local Authority Mechanical Test before a licence can be granted. Once passed the Local Authority Mechanical Test Certificate will remain valid for 12 months for vehicles less than 10 years old and valid for 6 months for vehicles aged 10 years of over.

A valid Local Authority Mechanical Test Certificate must be held throughout the duration of the licence period.

## 6. MOT Certificate

Please provide a copy of the current 'MOT Certificate' for the vehicle, regardless of whether the vehicle is under 3 years old. A new vehicle will require an MOT 12 months after first registration.
