

Modiwl Addysgu Ymarfer (Gwaith Cymdeithasol)

Mae'r modiwl wedi cael ei chymeradwyo gan Gofal Cymdeithasol Cymru, ac yn cael ei chyflwyno gan Brifysgol Bangor.

Bydd amcanion dysgu'r modiwl yn galluogi'r ymgeisydd i oruchwylio ac asesu myfyriwr gwaith cymdeithasol yn effeithiol.

Mae'r modiwl yn cael ei dysgu yn ddwyieithog (Cymraeg a Saesneg)

Rhaid i'r ymgeisydd ddangos:

- eu bod wedi cofrestru gyda Gofal Cymdeithasol Cymru, ac yna fod gofyn iddynt barhau ar y gofrestr i gael y credydau a nodir
- fod ganddynt gymhwyster gwaith cymdeithasol cydnabyddedig
- fod gennynt o leiaf 2 flynedd (neu gyfwerth ag amser llawn) o brofiad ôl-gymhwyso
- eu bod yn meddu ar y gallu, yr wybodaeth a phrofiad digonol ar gyfer natur a lefel y modiwl
- fod y modiwl yn berthnasol i'w datblygiad gyrfa fel y diffinnir yn eu cynllun dysgu
- fod gennynt gytundeb a chefnogaeth eu cyflogwr i gymryd rhan llawn ym mhob agwedd o'r rhaglen
- eu bod wedi cytuno i ddarparu cyfnod dysgu ac asesu ymarfer i fyfyriwr gwaith cymdeithasol sydd o leiaf 80 diwrnod er mwyn cwblhau'r modiwl

Practice Educating (Social Work) Module

The module has been approved by Social Care Wales, and is delivered by Prifysgol Bangor University.

The learning outcomes will enable the candidate to supervise and assess student social workers effectively.

The module is taught bilingually (Welsh and English).

Candidates must demonstrate that:

- they hold a recognised social work qualification
- they are registered social workers with Social Care Wales, and then be required to remain on the register to obtain the ascribed credits
- they have a minimum of 2 years (or full time equivalent) post qualification experience
- they have sufficient ability, knowledge and experience for the type and level of the module
- the module is relevant to their career development as defined in their learning plan
- they have the agreement and support of their employer to fully participate in all aspects of the programme
- they have agreed to provide a period of at least 80 days of practice educating and assessment for a student social worker to enable them to complete the module
