### **COVID-19: Newid i ofynion cyfreithiol 18 Ebrill 2022**

# COVID-19: Change to legal requirements

## 18 April 2022

Following its 3-weekly review of Coronavirus Regulations the Welsh Government has announced that from Monday, 18 April 2022, it will no longer be a legal requirement for businesses and organisations to carry out a coronavirus risk assessment and implement reasonable measures to minimise the risk.

Businesses are still encouraged to take steps to operate in a Covid-safe manner.

The wearing of face coverings will still remain a legal requirement in health and social care settings. To read the statement in full, go to:
