Draft Policy PCYFF 4 (NMC 90) states:

"Proposals will need to demonstrate how the energy hierarchy set out in Policy PS 6 has been applied and how the contribution from renewable or low carbon energy to satisfy the proposals need for energy and waste has been maximised." (MAC in bold)

Whilst Bourne Leisure firmly supports sustainable development, the Company considers that the approach to renewable or low carbon energy should be proportionate to the impact of the proposed development. As it is currently worded, this draft policy provides a "one-size-fits-all" approach, which would be onerous for smaller development proposals. The Company therefore requests that draft Policy PCYFF 4 is amended as follows:

"Proposals which will result in a significant demand for energy will need to demonstrate how the energy hierarchy set out in Policy PS 6 has been applied and how the contribution from renewable or low carbon energy to satisfy the proposals need for energy and waste has been maximised." (MAC in bold, proposed amendments in bold and underlined)

Bourne Leisure is also concerned with the following provision in the amended draft Policy PCYFF 4 (NMC 90):

"Residential development on sites for 100 housing units or more, and non-residential development of 100 sq. metres or more, will be required to submit a comprehensive Energy Assessment to determine the feasibility, including viability issues, of incorporating renewable or low carbon technology and/or, where appropriate, connect to renewable or low carbon technology." (MAC in bold)

Bourne Leisure considers that the threshold of 100 sqm for non-residential development for the requirement for an Energy Assessment is too low and would apply to very small developments. Furthermore, the requirement for a "comprehensive assessment" would be disproportionate to the scale of many smaller developments. The Company therefore requests that this threshold is increased to at least 1,000 sq m (to accord with the definition of major development) but provides flexibility to take into account the nature of the proposed non-residential development.

Bourne Leisure considers that, as drafted, emerging Policy PCYFF 4 does not meet the second soundness test (is the plan appropriate?) because it is not proportionate and does not take a logical, balanced approach in relation to the requirements for energy assessment.
