Bydd y Gorchymyn yn gweithredu ym mhob diwrnod o'r wythnos rhwng yr oriau 11.30 y bore a 4.00 y prynhawn.

Bydd cerbydau sydd wedi mynd i'r ffordd uchod cyn 11.30 y bore ond nad ydynt wedi gadael erbyn yr amser hwnnw yn cael caniatâd i wneud hynny o fewn hanner awr i'r amser hynny.

Yn anffodus, nid oes ffordd osgoi addas ar gael yn ystod cyfnod y cau.

Mae angen y Gorchymyn i osgoi'r tebygrwydd o berygl i'r cyhoedd o ganlyniad i'r gofyniad i gerddwyr a beicwyr pedalau gadw pellter cymdeithasol yn sgil y pandemic coronafeirws a'r posibilrwydd o wrthdaro â thraffig cerbydau.

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**SECTION 14(1) AS AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC**  
**(TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991**  
**THE TRAFFIC ORDERS PROCEDURE (AMENDMENT) (WALES) (CORONAVIRUS)**  
**REGULATIONS 2020**  
**THE GWYNEDD COUNCIL**  
**(CLOSURE OF EASTGATE STREET AND HIGH STREET CAERNARFON)**  
**(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Gwynedd Council intend not less than seven days from the date hereof to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit any person from causing any vehicle except pedal cycles to proceed along that length of road described below:

Eastgate Street Caernarfon from a point on its junction with Bangor Street in a westerly direction and onto High Street to its junction with the east side of Castel Street.

The Order will be operational every day of the week between the hours of 11.30am and 4.00 pm. Vehicles having entered the said length of road prior to 11.30 a.m. but not exited by that time will be permitted to do so within half an hour of that time.

Unfortunately, there is no suitable alternative route available during the road closure.

The Order is required to avoid the likelihood of danger to the public as a consequence for the requirement for pedestrians and pedal cyclist to maintain social distancing as a result of the coronavirus pandemic and the potential conflict with vehicle traffic.

The Order comes into effect on the 23<sup>rd</sup> April, 2021 and will continue in force for a period not exceeding six months.

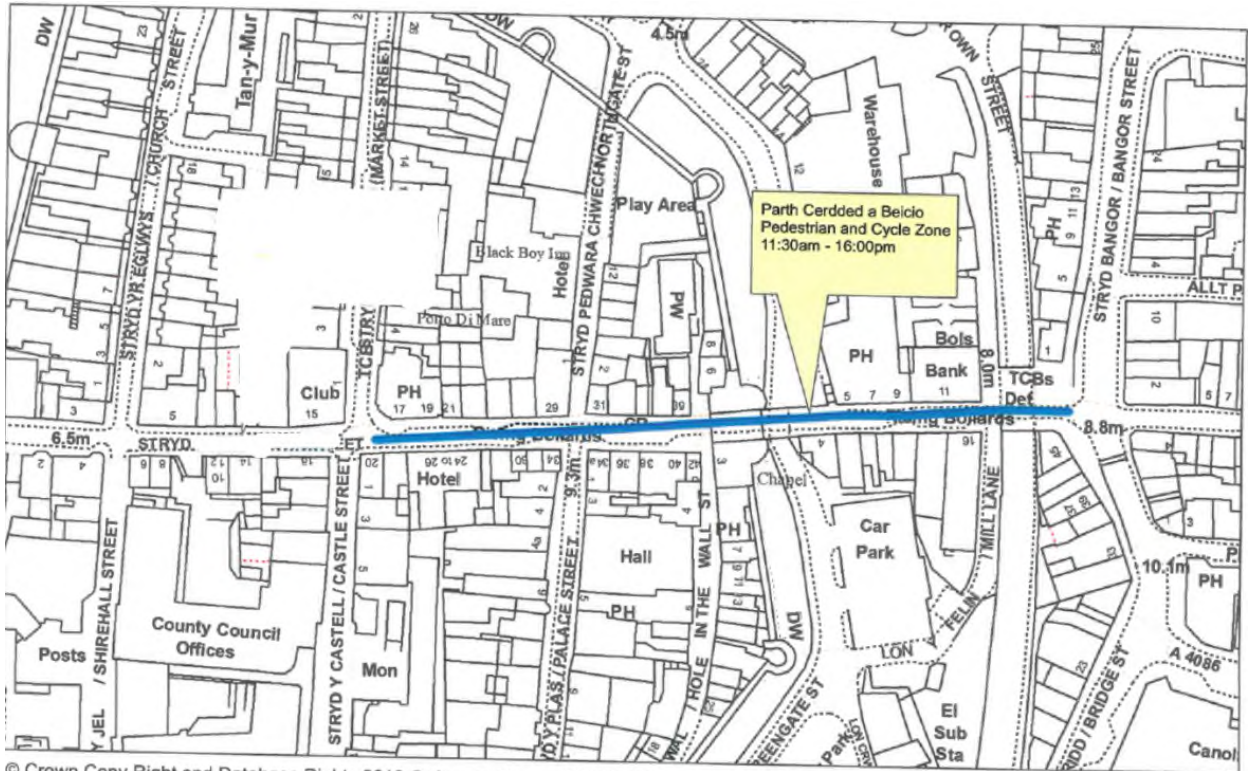
