

# ARIANNU HEDDLU GOGLEDD CYMRU / FUNDING NORTH WALES POLICE 2018-2019



Ym mis Mai 2016 cefais fy ethol yn Gomisiynydd yr Heddlu a Throsedd dros Ogledd Cymru. Fy ngwaith i yw sicrhau bod pobl Gogledd Cymru yn cael y gwasanaeth heddlu gorau posibl a bod pob dinesydd yn teimlo'n ddiogel, yn eu cartrefi ac ar ein strydoedd.

Un o fy mhrif gyfrifoldebau yw gosod y praesept blynyddol, sef y rhan honno o gyllideb yr heddlu sy'n dod o drethi lleol. Mae cyfanswm y gyllideb fydd ar gael i Heddlu Gogledd Cymru er mwyn plismona Gogledd Cymru yn dibynnu ar lefel y praesept. Mae ansawdd, effeithiolrwydd ac effeithlonrwydd gwaith yr heddlu yng Ngogledd Cymru yn dibynnu'n helaeth ar lefel y praesept - yn wir mae'r praesept yn hollbwysig i alluogi'r Heddlu i ofalu bod Gogledd Cymru yn parhau i fod yn lle diogel i fyw a gweithio ynddo ac i ymweld ag ef.

Yr wyf yn hynod o falch o'r hyn a gyflawnwyd gan fy swyddfa, Heddlu Gogledd Cymru a'n partneriaid yn ystod fy amser fel Comisiynydd. Rhai o'r pethau a gyflawnwyd yw:

- Cynllun **brysbennu iechyd meddwl** wedi ei redeg ar y cyd ar strydoedd Wrecsam.
- Caniatâd i adeiladu pencadlys rhanbarthol newydd gan **gynnwys dalfa** yn Llai, a gorsaf yng nghanol y dref yn Wrecsam.
- Cyflogi gweithiwr achos iechyd meddwl o fewn y Ganolfan Cymorth Dioddefwyr er mwyn bod o gymorth i ddiodefwyr sy'n dioddef o broblemau iechyd meddwl a gweithiwr achos penodol i weithio gyda diodefwyr **Caethwasiaeth Fodern**.
- Mae **Cronfa'r Comisiynydd** wedi noddi sawl prosiect a sefydliad i allu ymdrin â throsedd ac anhrefn ac i gefnogi diodefwyr. Rhoddir dros £2miliwn yn flynyddol i amrywiaeth o ddarparwyr gwasanaethau.
- Yr ydym wedi cefnogi a rhoi **cymorth i 14,168 o ddiodefwyr** (1,864 ohonynt yn blant neu'n bobl ifanc) sydd wedi dod i gysylltiad â'r **Ganolfan Cymorth Dioddefwyr**.
- Ffurfiwyd **tîm Ymyrraeth Gynnar** yn Sir y Fflint i weithio gyda'r rhai hynny sy'n cynhyrchu'r galw mwyaf o ran bygythiad, niwed a risg.
- Yr ydym wedi buddsoddi mewn **1,350 o ddyfeisiadau technoleg symudol** i alluogi swyddogion i chwilio am bobl, cerbydau a chyfeiriadau tra maent ar batrôl.

Mae cryn ansicrwydd faint fydd Gogledd Cymru'n ei dderbyn drwy fformiwla ariannu'r heddlu yn 2019/20 ac ar ôl hynny. Ar adeg o gyni, mae'n beth doeth i gorff cyhoeddus gynyddu'r treth y cyngor a chynyddu'r gronfa wrth gefn. Ond er imi gael ar ddeall wrth ymgynghori fod llawer o bobl yng Ngogledd Cymru o blaid cynyddu treth y cyngor o 4% neu ragor, rhaid sylweddoli ar yr un pryd y byddai rhai pobl yn ei chael yn anodd talu ychydig ychwaneg, hyd yn oed. Mae fy nghronfa wrth gefn mewn cyflwr sefydlog ac iach ac yn wyneb hynny rwyf wedi penderfynu cynyddu treth y cyngor er mwyn ariannu gwariant 2018/19 yn unig, gan ddelio ag effaith gostyngiad pellach yng ngrnt y llywodraeth pan, neu os, gwelwn hyn yn digwydd.

Mae'r Prif Gwnstabl yn fy sicrhau y bydd cynnydd o 3.58% yn ei alluogi i gyflawni fy Nghynllun Heddlu a Throsedd, a gyhoeddwyd yn 2017, yn effeithiol.

I was elected to be the Police and Crime Commissioner for North Wales in May 2016. My job is to make sure that the people of North Wales have the best police service possible and that citizens feel safe both at home and on our streets.

One of my main responsibilities is to set the annual precept which is that part of the police budget which is raised from local taxes. The level of the precept determines the total budget available to North Wales Police for policing North Wales. The precept's importance to the quality, effectiveness and efficiency of policing North Wales is vital as it is to the ability of the Force to keep north Wales a safe place to live, work and visit.

I am extremely proud of the work and achievements of my office, North Wales Police and our partners during my time in office. Some of the things we have achieved are:

- A jointly operated **mental health street triage** in Wrexham.
- The approval to build a new divisional headquarters and **custody suite** in Llay, and town centre police station in Wrexham.
- The employment of a mental health caseworker within the Victim Help Centre to help victims experiencing mental health problems and a dedicated caseworker to support victims of **Modern Day Slavery**.
- **The Commissioner's Fund** provides funding to numerous projects and organisations to help tackle crime and disorder and to support victims. Just over £2m is given each year to a wide variety of service providers.
- We engaged and **helped 14,168 victims** (1,864 of whom were children and young people) who made contact with the **Victims' Help Centre**.
- A joint **Early Intervention Team** was formed in Flintshire to work with those who generate the highest demand with regard to threat, harm and risk.
- We have invested in **1,350 mobile technology devices** which have been deployed to enable officers to search for people, vehicles and addresses while on patrol.

There is considerable uncertainty over what North Wales Police will receive from the police funding formula in 2019/20 and beyond. In times of austerity, the prudent course for a public body would be to increase council tax and increase reserves. However, this needs to be balanced with the recognition that, although many North Wales residents responded to my consultation in support of increasing council tax by 4% or more, there are others who may find it difficult to find even a small amount of additional money. My reserves are in a stable and healthy position, and therefore I have decided to increase council tax only in order to fund 2018/19 expenditure, and to deal with the effect of further reductions in government grant if and when this should occur.

The Chief Constable assures me that an increase of 3.58% enables him to effectively deliver against my Police and Crime Plan, which was published in 2017.

**Cymharu lefel y Gyllideb Refeniw â  
chanllawiau Llywodraeth Cymru**

Gan ddefnyddio fformiwla a luniwyd ar gyfer pob Heddlu yng Nghymru a Lloegr, mae Llywodraeth Cymru a'r Swyddfa Gartref wedi cyflwyno "safon gwariant" a elwir yn Asesiad Gwariant Safonol (AGS) a Grant yr Heddlu o £123.381m ar gyfer 2018-2019. Dyma yw asesiad y Llywodraeth o'r hyn y bydd angen i'r Comisiynydd ei wario er mwyn darparu'r un lefel o wasanaeth â'r Comisiynydd Heddlu a Throsedd eraill yng Nghymru os ydynt hwythau hefyd yn gwario yn unol â chyfanswm eu AGS a'u Grant Heddlu eu hunain.

Mae gan y Comisiynydd hawl i wario mwy na chyfanswm yr AGS a'r Grant Heddlu, gyda'r gwahaniaeth yn cael ei ariannu gan Dreth y Cyngor neu o'r Cronfeydd Wrth Gefn. Mae'r Comisiynydd wedi penderfynu ar ofyniad Cyllideb o £146,467m.

**How much of your council  
tax is spent on policing?**

There are nine council tax bands in North Wales, based on the capital value of the property in 2003.

\*Band D is used for National comparisons of tax levels. From a Band D Council Tax bill, only £258.12 is allocated to funding the Police service of North Wales, as agreed by the Police and Crime Commissioner for North Wales.

Therefore, depending on your property band, the amount from your Council tax bill which funds the Police Service of North Wales is as follows:

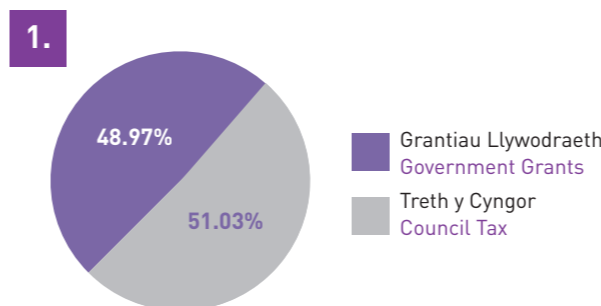
**Comparison of the level of the Revenue Budget  
with the Welsh Government's guidance**

Using a formula developed for all Police Forces in England and Wales, the Welsh Government (WG) and the Home Office have issued the Commissioner with a "spending norm" known as the Standard Spending Assessment (SSA) plus Police Grant of £123.381m for 2018-2019. This is the Government's assessment of the Commissioner's need to spend in order to provide the same level of service as other Police and Crime Commissioners in Wales if they also spend at the level of their own SSA plus Police grant.

The Commissioner is allowed to spend in excess of its SSA/Police grant total, with the excess being funded from the Council Tax or Reserves. The Commissioner has set a Budget requirement of £146,467m.

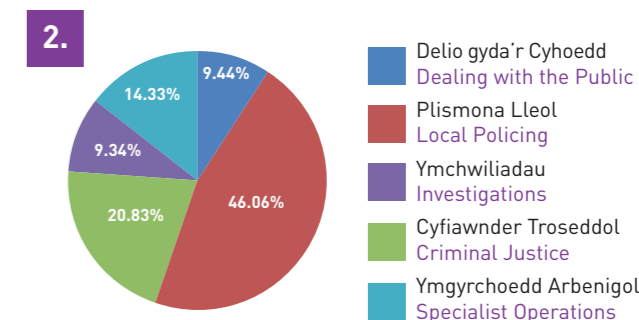
