





#BeAdventureSmart Follow government guidelines

Guidelines for England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland differ
Check government websites for the area you are visiting and comply with them

Protect local communities

Be prepared to find some car parks, toilets, shops & other local amenities closed. Plan your trip well & respect local residents.

Keep your distance

If it looks busy it's too busy, be prepared to change your plans & find somewhere less crowded. Stay 2 m away from others at all times, sanitise your hands frequently & avoid touching gates, stiles etc.

Know your limits

Stick to activities and locations which are within your comfort zone.

Plan your day

Ask yourself 3 questions before you set off:
• Do I know what the weather will be like?
• Do I have the right gear?
• Do I have the knowledge and skills for the day?

More than a walk in the park!



The Llanberis path is not an easy walk

Though it is the most gradual route, expect 7 hours of difficult walking up & down

- It is colder, windier & often wetter at the top, even in summer
- Winter conditions are challenging even for experienced walkers
- You need warm layers, a waterproof jacket, walking shoes, food & drink & a torch
- There is no shelter on the path & the summit building can close without notice, especially in poor weather
- If you walk up, you need to be prepared to walk down, trains are for pre-booked passengers only
- Mountain rescue teams are voluntary organisations and respond to life/limb-threatening emergencies only
