Gwynedd Council has an ISO9001 grant scheme available in the 2022/2023 financial year which sets requirements for a quality management system and ISO14001 which sets requirements for an environmental management system. The grant scheme contributes towards the costs of a consultant to work with businesses in order to reach the standards necessary for certification. The cost of the certification itself is not included in the scheme. The Council also has a Loan Fund for improving town center properties and a Digital Platform Improvement Scheme which could be beneficial in terms of resource efficiency.
