## **FUNDING: HYBRID SBRI 2.1 – Feasibility funding competition now open**

Funding from this competition will enable businesses and organisations to deliver further decarbonisation innovation and research solutions supporting objectives identified by the Wales Hydrogen Pathway report, through the successful deployment of hydrogen across the Welsh economy. Phase 1 funding is available for feasibility and development (R&D) contracts for projects with costs up to £50,000 inclusive of VAT. The submission deadline for project proposals is 14 December 2022. ## **AGRICULTURE: New measures to tackle avian influenza**
