The Welsh Government's £5.25m Cultural Winter Stability Fund will open for applications on Wednesday 12 January 2022, covering the period from 1 October 2021 to 31 March 2022. The fund will assist Wales' arts organisations, museums, libraries and independent cinemas at risk of closure or job losses as a direct result of the ongoing impact of COVID-19.
