COVID-19: Required use of the NHS COVID Pass to be extended

COVID-19: Risk assessments still required at Alert Level 0

Wales remains at Alert Level 0, with all businesses able to open. Carrying out a coronavirus risk assessment continues to be a legal requirement for all businesses, employers and event organisers and reasonable measures to minimise the risk of coronavirus must be implemented. Particular attention should be paid to:

- Social distancing, particularly in busy areas
- Good ventilation
- Good hand hygiene
- Wearing of face masks – indoor public places, including on public transport, in shops and in healthcare settings
