### **FUNDING: £3m funding scheme for marine, fisheries and aquaculture projects**

The Welsh Government has announced a £3m funding scheme to support the fisheries, marine and aquaculture sectors. It will be available over two years and replaces the previous European Maritime and Fisheries Fund. The Expression of Interest (EoI) window is now open and closes on 13 January 2023.
