BREXIT: Businesses to be given UK product marking flexibility

The UK Government has announced that businesses will be given an additional 2 years to apply the new UK Conformity Assessed (UKCA) product safety marking, and will continue to recognise the CE marking until 31 December 2024. Until then, businesses have the flexibility to choose which marking to apply. For more information, go to:

FUNDING: Historic Buildings Capital Grant Programme

A new Cadw funded grant focusing on the repair of listed buildings at risk, or in a vulnerable condition, is available to private individuals and not for profit organisations. The Historic Building Capital Grant Programme can fund 50% of eligible works (up to a maximum of £250,000) to safeguard listed buildings at risk into the future, for the benefit of the wider community. Expressions of Interest (EOI) submissions are required by 23 December 2022. For more information, go to:
