NEWS: Welsh Government Brilliant Basics Fund

Gwynedd Council has received funding for two projects from the Welsh Government's Brilliant Basics Fund to upgrade facilities

and increase the benefit to the local economy from tourism. Parc Padarn, in Llanberis, will undergo a major upgrade to include EV Points, installation of bike racks and recycling bins and resurfacing the car park. The Aros-fan project will upgrade assets such as public car parks in 6 destinations across Gwynedd, located within walking distance to key towns, to develop a network of locations by spring 2023 that will create legitimate provision for 'overnight' parking and sleeping throughout the year for motor homes in the county. UK Government grants of £5,000 are now available for homeowners choosing to replace fossil fuel boilers with low-carbon heat pumps.
