INTRODUCTION



In 2021, Cyngor Gwynedd Regeneration Board agreed to develop a new Regeneration Framework. The intention of the Framework is to ensure that proactive steps are in place to ensure collaboration to improve the areas economically, environmentally, socially and culturally.

As part of that Framework, the county has been divided into 13 Local Regeneration Areas and an action plan has been created for each of the areas. This is the action plan for the Dolgellau area.



Local Regeneration Areas: Bangor Area, Dyffryn Ogwen Area, Bro Peris Area, Caernarfon Area, Bro Lleu / Nantlle Area, Pen Llŷn Area, Pwllheli Area, Porthmadog / Penrhyndeudraeth Area, Bro Ffestiniog Area, Bro Ardudwy Area, Bala Penllyn Area, Dolgellau Area and Tywyn & Bro Dysynni Area.

'Regeneration' has been defined as a deliberate effort to improve areas economically, environmentally, socially or culturally. The Framework also recognises a key role for communities to identify local priorities; and the contribution of local organisations in developing action plans.

Following an engagement process in 2022 and listening to the opinions of local people, the plan includes the vision and priorities of each community for the future. With working in partnership at the core of the arrangements, it is hoped that it will provide a clear path to steps that can bring positive change to communities that will change lives for the better. The aim of the plan is therefore to be a guide to investment locally as well as influence policy decisions in all areas - from health and education to transport and planning.

GWYNEDD REGENERATION FRAMEWORK

The Regeneration Framework for Gwynedd focuses on deliberate efforts to improve areas economically, environmentally, socially and culturally in order to create healthy, prosperous, dynamic and sustainable communities ensuring the input and contribution of a wide range of local organisations.

'OUR AREA' ENGAGEMENT



The aim of the 'Our Area' (Ardal Ni) campaign was to hold a conversation with local communities in order to identify what is important to residents and how they would like to see their area develop over the next 10-15 years



Consultation and engagement with each community has been a key part of drawing up the action plans. There were three stages to the consultation held under the banner of 'Ardal Ni 2035'

- An initial discussion was held with town and community councils together with local organisations, groups and councilors receiving 9 responses on ideas about what should be the local priorities for the area in the period up to 2035. These responses were used as a basis for the second stage of wider engagement with the public.
- A public engagement campaign was organized to give residents the opportunity to voice their opinion regarding the challenges facing their area, what is important to them and what developments they want to see in their area over the next 10 to 15 years . 273 responses were received from the Dolgellau Area through an online and paper questionnaire
- Following public sessions, workshops were held with organisations to discuss action plans focusing on the issues and priorities that had been identified locally.



DOLGELLAU AREA TODAY



Dolgellau area is located in South Snowdonia and the town of Dolgellau is central to the area. This area plan includes the communities of Llanelltyd, Ganllwyd, Mawddwy, Brithdir, Llanfachreth, Rhydymain, Dolgellau, Arthog and Corris.



Dolgellau Area summary in figures

Strengths

Compares better than the average of Wales or Gwynedd

- **85** life expectancy for women, higher than the Welsh figure of 82.3
- **80.5** of men's life expectancy, higher than the Welsh figure of 78.3
- **12.3%** percentage of children who are obese below 13% for Gwynedd
- **1.93** (rate per 100) anti-social behavior recorded by the Police lower than 2.52 for Gwynedd
- **83.8** percentage of adults (ages 25-64) with a qualification higher than 80.6% for Wales
- **9%** percentage of people in income deprivation lower than 13% for Gwynedd

Weaknesses

Does not compare as well as the average of Wales or Gwynedd

- **79.5%** a percentage that enjoys good or very good health which is lower than the Gwynedd figure (81.1%)
- **5.77%** high value jobs lower than 13.6% for Wales
- 13% percentage of houses that are holiday homes higher than the figure for Gwynedd (11%) and Wales (3%)
- **34%** probability of houses in poor condition higher than Gwynedd (29%) and Wales (19%)
- **62%** percentage who can speak Welsh slightly less than the Gwynedd figure of 65%

- Lack of suitable and affordable housing for local people to buy or rent (129)
- No opportunities to keep young people in the area(126)

- The public transport network in the area is insufficient (101)
- There is concern about the condition of roads, traffic and parking in a number of locations (72)
