## Purpose of the annual report:

The aim of the Annual Report is to assist the electorate to become better informed of the work and activities of their elected local authority member during the year.

#### The following constituency activities were held:

- I have been working on a project to improve the standards of the area's public footpaths by walking along the paths to ensure standards with other Councillors from Nefyn Town Council. We succeeded in securing a grant for almost £300,000 for that purpose
- In collaboration with the parents of the children of Nefyn, we have persuaded Gwynedd Council to provide a safe path to the school
- I worked on a project to improve Y Groes and I successfully secured £9,000 for new seats and a unique fence
- I secured allotments for Nefyn residents, a project worth £7,000
- I received funding, approximately £3000 to plant Bardsey Island apple trees in the town
- Working in collaboration with others, we established Menter Llŷn, as well as Siop Siarad. Siop Siarad is a place for teenagers to gather together in the evenings to use computers, it is also a place for unemployed people to use computers
- I have been in discussions with and putting pressure on Gwynedd Council to re-surface the road in Old Nefyn Town and to make improvements to the road between Nefyn and Pistyll for the sake of the safety of local residents and tourists.
- I have been busy trying to secure a playing field for Penwaig Nefyn Football Team in Bryn Mynach. At present, along with my fellow members of the Town Council, we have raised £35,000 from various sources. We have also ensured a £15,000 from Mantell Gwynedd and Cist. We will now move on to try and enable us to get a quality multi-purpose playing field here in Nefyn
- Recently I have spent a lot of time trying to secure the future of Nefyn library.
- I am working with others to try to secure a subsidy to revive the area's old clay mines. The aim is to include local schools in the project and use technical equipment, gazebos and create nature interpretation areas.
