Purpose of the annual report:

The aim of the Annual Report is to assist the electorate to become better informed of the work and activities of their elected local authority member during the year.

Role and responsibilities:

Member for Talysarn Ward. Member of the Services Scrutiny Committee, Planning Committee, Central/General Licensing Committee, and Chairman of Gwyrfai Area Forum.

The following constituency activities were held:

Arbed Scheme: The Arbed Scheme was arranged by Gwynedd Council and Willmott Dixon and it has been a great success for the residents of Carmel and Fron. The Chairman of the Fron Residents Society and I have been involved in the scheme from the beginning, with over two years of planning work. It was been a huge investment for the people of Carmel and Fron. The houses are much warmer after receiving external cladding/insultating material as well as new boilers and double-glazed windows, free of charge. The Arbed Scheme was funded jointly by Welsh Government and Gwynedd Council.

Football fields secured: Carmel and Fron football fields were secured after my request to Llandwrog Community Council and they have now been adopted by the Council.

Surgeries: I hold surgeries on the first Monday of each month.

Flying Start: A new Flying Start building has been built in Talysarn and was funded by Welsh Government.

The following initiatives and activities were held:

- As a result of receiving complaints from Llandwrog Parish Council, I successfully campaigned to get the road past Maes Hyfryd in Carmel resurfaced. I also secured the re-surfacing of the road at Trallwyn Terrace in the direction of Cilgwyn as there was concern regarding the state of the road
- I am also in the process of campaigning to have a new layer of tarmac laid on Pisgah Road, and the campaign to fill potholes in Carmel is ongoing
- I also succeeded in getting bollards placed near Cilgwyn Lodge, Carmel after receiving complaints from the owner, as well as a new drain on Lôn Tŷ Bryn and near Goleufryn, in Carmel.
- A new drainage system from Green Bank to Goleufryn
- I have also met regularly with the PCSO and others from North Wales Police to discuss policing in the Talysarn ward
- Ongoing repairs and improvements including new signage for safety reasons
- In August 2014 I was at the unveiling of the memorial for the Welshmen who perished at Ypres, Belgium.
