- Visit Llanbedr primary school regularly.
- With the assistance of the Tidy Towns Officer, I managed to get posters done and put up around the area reminding visitors and local people to place litter in the bin and also to pick up and dispose of dog faeces.
- Meeting with the Highways Department in an effort to solve the problem of speeding down towards the Maes car park in Llandanwg. As a result of setting up a traffic meter on the road, the Council intends to move the 30mph sign further down towards Llandanwg.
- Campaigned with Network Rail officers at meetings of the Cambrian Coast Liaison Committee to install barriers on the crossing at Talwrn Bach, Llanbedr. This work was proposed to commence this year, however, unfortunately as Carillion had folded, the tendering process would have to commence once more.
- Continue to campaign to get a bypass. Following several consultations, the hope now is that the scheme will go before the National Park's Planning Committee soon.
