Main Electoral and Community Activities

- I am Chair of the Hospital Appeal Fund Committee
- Over the years, the Appeal Committee has contributed £100,000 to the Hospital's Xray Unit, £20,000 towards an eye scanner, and by now we have also given a special bath. The work of the Appeal Committee continues
- I gave up my seat as Chair of Ysgol Penybryn Governing Body some years ago after many years in the Chair. As I noted, the investment of £1.8 million for the Hall was greatly welcomed. I continue to have an interest in the School's work
- During the year, I met with other Councillors, Gwynedd Council Officers, the Assembly Member Dafydd Elis-Thomas and the Member of Parliament Liz Saville Roberts on several occasions regarding constituency matters.
