### **Main Electoral and Community Activities**

- Continue to work in the Community and collaborate with Local Community Councils to make sure that the community's interests are protected
- Have succeeded to get a yellow background to the 40 m.p.h. signs on either side of the road by the entrance to the Pensarn Christian Centre, following the placing of the red stripes on each side of the road
- Helping whenever possible in the soup kitchen held for the elderly of the villages of Llanbedr and Llanfair. This is an opportunity to have a chat with the residents who attend and listen to their concerns and complaints
- Regularly visit the Primary School in Llanbedr and present awards to the pupils at the end of the summer term
- Hold meetings with some of the Llandanwg residents, and listen to their concerns, such as the local café's application for an alcohol licence
- Continue to campaign with Network Rail officers to install barriers on the crossing at Talwrn Bach, Llanbedr.
- Meetings to discuss the bypass and the wish for the Plan to be submitted to the National Park's Planning Committee once again
- Meeting of the Llandanwg Dunes Protection Group to listen to their concerns about the erosion of the dunes on the beach, and the work that they are doing in an attempt to prevent this erosion
- Attended the ceremony of switching on the Christmas lights in Llanbedr, and I was part of a social evening that was held following the event
- Arrange to go litter picking around the Village with some of the local residents
- I am the Treasurer of Ardudwy's Annual Eisteddfod and have been for many years and enjoy attending
- Attending Ysgol Llanbedr's Christmas Fair and Christmas Show
- Attending Ysgol Ardudwy's Carol Service
