Rhannu y grant o £3,531,718 gan Gyfarwyddiaeth yr Amgylchedd a Datblygu Cynaliadwy Llywodraeth Cymru sydd wedi ei neilltuo i Gyngor Gwynedd o fel a ganlyn yn 2016/17:

RHESYMAU DROS Y PENDERFYNIAD/REASONS FOR THE DECISION

Ers mis Ebrill 2015 mae'r Gyfarwyddiaeth Amgylchedd a Datblygu Cynaliadwy o fewn Llywodraeth Cymru wedi bod yn gyfrifol am weinyddu un ffynhonell grant ar gyfer awdurdodau lleol yn hytrach na'r amrywiaeth o wahanol grantiau oedd yn bodoli ar gyfer y maes yn y gorffennol.

Rhaid i'r gwaith a wneir gan ddefnyddio'r arian fod yn rhan o gylch gwaith Cyfarwyddiaeth yr Amgylchedd a Datblygu Cynaliadwy a rhaid iddo fynd i'r afael â blaenoriaethau'r Gweinidog, sef:

- Annog twf gwyrdd
- Gwydnwch a diogelwch
- Cydweithio er mwyn darparu gwasanaethau gwell a sicrhau darpariaeth rheng flaen
- Cymru decach

Bydd dyraniad yr arian i awdurdodau lleol yn yn lleihau o 4% yn 2016/17 tra bydd disgwyl hefyd i gynnwys elfennau megis bioamrywiaeth a phobl a safleoedd (oedd ddim wedi eu cynnwys yng nghais y Cyngor yn 2015/16). Yn ogystal, disgwylir i'r ceisiadau a gyflwynir roi sylw penodol i gyfraniad tuag at nodau y Ddeddf Llesiant a Chenedlaethau'r Dyfodol.

Bu swyddogion allweddol o fewn yr Adran Priffyrdd a Bwrdeistrefol, Adran Ymgynghoriaeth a'r Adran Rheoleiddio yn gyfrifol am lunio'r cynnig a amlinellir ac mae cytundeb ynghylch defnydd a rhanniad y grant ar gyfer 2016/17.

Since April 2015, the Environment and Sustainable Development Directorate within Welsh Government has been responsible for administering one grant source for local authorities rather than the various grants that used to exist in the field in the past.

The work undertaken by using this money must be a part of the remit of the Environment and Sustainable Development Directorate and it must address the Minister's priorities, namely:

- *Promotion of green growth*
- *Resilience and safety*
- *Collaboration in order to provide better services and ensuring front-line provision*
- *A fairer Wales*

The allocation of funding to local authorities will reduce 4% in 2016/17 whilst it will also be expected for elements such as biodiversity, people and sites (which were not included in the Council's bid in 2015/16) to be included. In addition, the applications submitted will be expected to give particular attention to the aims of the Well-being of Future Generations Act.

Key officers from the Highways and Municipal Department, Consultancy Department and Regulatory Department were responsible for drawing-up the outlined proposal and there is agreement regarding the use and allocation of the grant for 2016/17.

Therefore, for 2016/17, the following projects will be implemented by using the grant received from the Environment and Sustainable Development Directorate:

Mae'r grant gweddilliol ar ôl y toriad wedi'i ddsbarthu rhwng Rheoli Adnoddau Naturiol (Ymgynghoriaeth a Rheoleiddio), Rheoli Gwastraff a Defnydd Adnoddau'n Effeithlon (Bwrdeistrefol), ac Ansawdd Amgylchedd Lleol (Bwrdeistrefol) fel nodir ar y daflen, ac mae'r rhaniad wedi ei gytuno rhwng y Penaethiaid.

I confirm that the grant for 2016/17 has reduced £136k compared to 2015/16 (approximately 4% lower). The residual grant has been distributed between Natural Resources Management (Consultancy and Regulatory Departments), Waste Management and Efficient Use of Resources (Municipal), and the Quality of the Local Environment (Municipal) as noted on the sheet, and the split has been agreed between the Heads.
