**3.1 PS3/Overhead Cables :** PS3 states in the context of information and communications technology infrastructure that '*to lessen the visual impact of new overhead lines associated with developments, especially in sensitive locations, they should be placed underground.*' This should also apply to electricity transmission cables, particularly in relation to new renewable energy developments, where limitation of visual impact on the landscape is particularly important. Moreover, the possible cumulative loading implications of new projects for capacity of the existing transmission lines should be clearly established to avoid unforeseen needs for later upgrading of overhead lines with a resulting risk of adverse visual impact. It is not enough to leave these matters in the hands of the District Network Operator.




