

WHAT IS THE REGENERATION SUPPORT FUND

As part of the UK Shared Prosperity programme, around £20m has been earmarked for Gwynedd County with some of the money committed for the establishment of Funds for supporting Regeneration projects.

The Community Regeneration fund offers 3 grant schemes.

1. Small grant of capital or revenue (£10,000 - £25,000)

2. Regeneration Project Implementation Grants:

- a) Revenue only (£25,001 - £75,000)
- b) Capital and revenue (£25,001 - £200,000)

We can consider applications that are.

- Encourage communities to take a more proactive role in their communities
- Identify and respond to the needs and priorities of the community that have been identified within your area
- Boost investment and development of the local economy
- Improve locations important to communities
- Increase job opportunities, skills development among individuals within communities and promote equal opportunities for all

Types of projects/items that can be funded include

- Funding for the improvement of town centres
- Equipment's or improvements to protect community assets and provide new Services
- Local environment improvement projects
- Equipment or improvements to protect parks, green areas
- New full- or part-time positions. (If you are applying for a contribution towards the cost of a job, a business plan will need to be submitted to show how the job or activity will be conducted beyond the grant period).
- Business Plan
- Feasibility Assessment
- Professional fees

Type of day items not eligible:

- Equipment and building maintenance costs
- Costs of carrying out existing activities
- Pre-existing job salaries
- Activities carried out outside of Gwynedd
- Applications from individuals or applications from for-profit companies excluding social enterprises)

Note the above list is just examples, and we encourage you to have a detailed look at the intervention and outputs table on the detailed guidance document, which provides further information on the types of projects this fund can fund.

WHEN SHOULD AN APPLICATION BE SUBMITTED

The opening date of the funds is **5th June 2023**

The deadline to submit applications to the funds is **5.00 pm July 14, 2023**

We will aim to assess and approve applications by the end of August 2023

It will not be possible to fund any activity that has started before a letter of offer has been signed and returned to Gwynedd Council officers

Currently, we do not anticipate opening a second round to apply for the funds. An additional round may be open should demand in the first round be low.

WHO CAN APPLY

The fund is open to any not-for-profit organisation, to apply for grants through the fund, (excluding social enterprises), and which complies with the application guidelines.

HOW TO APPLY?

Applications can be made to the Regeneration Support Fund by completing the application form. It is important that you follow the instructions carefully and ensure that your project responds to the guidelines and criteria.

Before submitting your application, we are keen that you contact your Local Communities Support Officer to discuss your ideas and intentions. This will enable you to receive further support before submitting your application. The officer will be able to assist you in determining eligibility for your projects.
