




We are looking at

What's the plan?

We will make it safer and easier to walk, wheel and cycle near Faenol Roundabout. We will do this by:

Putting traffic lights on Faenol Roundabout so people can cross the road safely

Reducing the speed limit to 50mph

Widening the walking and cycling path on Faenol Hill

Improving the junction at Penrhos Road so people can cross safely
