

PUBLIC ACCESS TO THE INTERNET POLICY

Public access to the Internet will be provided by the Gwynedd Archives Service as part of its objective of promoting the use of information and an awareness of its value. The provision is part of the Service's strategy of contributing to or establishing networking and co-operative systems to ensure that information and items are supplied effectively, including the use of information technology.

The Gwynedd Archives Service has no control over the information to which access is provided and cannot be held responsible for the content or the quality of the information presented.

It is forbidden to transfer any illegal material. This includes, but is not restricted to, copyright acts, pornographic material or material protected by commercial laws. Use is not permitted for commercial purposes.

As in the case of all Archives material, use made by children of the access to the Internet is the responsibility of the child's parent(s) or those responsible for him/her.

Through this policy the statement is made that access to the Internet should be used only for research and information.

No fee is charged for using access to the Internet but a charge will be made for pages printed using Archives Service equipment.

It is permitted to save material on a disk supplied by the Archives Service but it is not permitted to save material on disk or transfer information from a disk for the use of the Internet.
