Llanbedr: Improving Transport

March 2026

It notes that a grant of up to £400,000 has been secured for 2026/27 which will be used to undertake the WeITAG Stage 3 process and associated activities which will include:

- finalising preferred route alignment and design refinements
- updating cost estimates, risk assessments and carbon impact analysis
- progressing land matters

An economic assessment and environmental assessments are currently being undertaken.

In recent weeks, ecologists from Ymgynghoriaeth Gwynedd Consultancy (YGC) have begun carrying out a series of ecological surveys in the area. This work will continue through the remainder of 2026 and into next year. The surveys include monitoring of wildlife such as bats, otters, badgers and birds, and the surveys can take place in the early morning or evening.

Tree surveys to monitor lichens are also underway. In addition, repairs around the bat enclosure will be ongoing and into April.

YGC designers are also completing minor changes to the road design with the work nearing completion. YGC officials will soon begin contacting landowners who may be affected by the proposed design. Meetings will be scheduled to discuss the plan in more detail.
