

Rhybudd o fwriad gan Gyngor Gwynedd i wneud gorchymyn parcio cwmpasog newydd
yn amharu ar nifer o feysydd parcio yng Ngwynedd.

Gorchymyn Cyngor Gwynedd (Lleoliadau Parcio Oddi Ar y Stryd) (Cydgrynhoi) 2026

(y gorchymyn parcio)

Cyngor Gwynedd (y Cyngor) yw'r awdurdod sy'n gwneud y gorchymyn, ac wrth wneud y gorchymyn parcio byddant yn gallu rheoli meysydd parcio, a chodi ffi parcio ar y mannau parcio yn y meysydd parcio perthnasol. Y mae'r meysydd parcio wedi cael eu rhestru yn atodlen 1 o'r gorchymyn parcio drafft, ac mae eu lleoliad wedi ei ddangos o fewn llinell goch ar y cynlluniau yn atodlen 4.

Ceir y manylion canlynol yn atodlenni 1 hyd 3 i'r drafft gorchymyn parcio: y dosbarthiadau o gerbydau y gellir parcio yn y meysydd parcio (1); y cyfyngiadau amser (os o gwbl) pan ni chaniateir parcio, a'r dosbarthiadau o gerbydau (2); a ffioedd parcio penodedig, fel y maent yn berthnasol i bob dosbarth o gerbyd(3) . Yn benodol y mae Atodlen 3 yn sôn am docynnau parcio a gynigir gan y Cyngor.

Dyma'r newidiadau:

1. Yn y meysydd parcio arhosiad hir (band 2) y cyfnod lleiaf y gellir talu i barcio bydd hyd at 4 awr. Y mae hyn yn cymharu â'r cyfnod hyd at 2 awr bresennol. Diddymir y ffi am hyd at 2 awr. Mi fydd y ffi am barcio hyd at 4 awr yn cynyddu o £2.80 hyd £3.50.
2. Bydd y cyfnod gorfodi am barcio yn y meysydd parcio arhosiad byr yn cael ei ymestyn i 9:00yb hyd 5:00yh. Cymharir hyn â'r cyfnod presennol o 10:00yb hyd 4:30yh.

Ac eithrio'r hyn a sonnir uchod wrth wneud y gorchymyn parcio ni fydd y ffioedd parcio yn newid, ond yn y dyfodol gall y ffioedd godi ond cyn gwneud hyn bydd rhaid i'r Cyngor roi rhybudd o newid.

Ni chrëir un maes parcio newydd, a bwriad creu'r gorchymyn parcio yw cysoni amodau parcio yn y nifer meysydd parcio. Ar hyn o bryd y mae'r meysydd parcio wedi eu creu drwy nifer o orchmynion pario gwahanol, gydag amodau parcio unigryw eu hunain. Wrth greu'r gorchymyn parcio presennol mi fydd yr amodau parcio yn gyffredin i'r meysydd parcio. Y gobaith yw fydd yr amodau newydd, cyffredin yn glir i'r defnyddwyr y mannau parcio a hefyd i'r Cyngor.

Mi fydd y gorchymyn drafft a'r atodlenni a Datganiad o Resymau'r Cyngor i wneud y gorchymyn parcio wedi eu rhoi er mwyn i'r cyhoedd eu gweld yn rhad a ddim yn Siop Gwynedd, Stryd y Castell, Caernarfon, Gwynedd LL55 1SH (1); Siop Gwynedd, Swyddfeydd y Cyngor, Cae Penarlâg, Dolgellau, LL40 2YB (2); a hefyd Siop Gwynedd, Swyddfeydd y Cyngor, Ffordd y Cob, Pwllheli, Gwynedd LL53 5YT (3) rhwng Llun a Gwener a rhwng yr oriau 9:00yb a 4:00yh. Gwynedd Council's notice of proposal to make a consolidated parking order for a
number of car parks at Gwynedd

Gwynedd Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2026
(the parking order)

Gwynedd Council (the Council) is the order making authority, and in making the parking order the Council will be able to manage and raise a parking fee at their relevant car parks. The car parks have been listed in Schedule 1 to the draft parking order, and their locations are seen by red edging on the maps found in Schedule 4 to the draft parking order.

The following details are found in Schedules 1 to 3 to the draft parking order: the classes of vehicles that are allowed to park on the car parks (1); the time restrictions (if any) when parking is not allowed, and the appropriate classes of vehicles (2); and the prescribed parking fees, as relevant to each class of vehicle (3). Schedule 3 mentions parking permits offered by the Council.

Below are details of the changes:

1. In the long stay car parks (band 2) the least period that users can pay will be that of up to 4 hours. This compares to the present period of up to 2 hours. The parking fee for the 2 hour period will no longer prevail, and the fee for the 4 hour period will increase from £2.80 to £3.50.
2. In the short stay car parks the enforcement period will be extended to 9:00am to 5:00pm. This compares to the current period of 10:00am to 4:30pm.

Save for the above, in making the current parking order the prescribed parking fees will remain unchanged, and before effecting a future fee increase the Council will need to issue a notice of variation.

Also no new car parks will be created, and the intention in making the parking order is to standardise the parking terms and conditions for all of the car parks. Presently the car parks have been created by numerous different parking orders, with their own terms and conditions. By making the parking order all car parks will have the same, common terms and conditions. The aim being is that the new common terms and conditions will be clear to the users of the parking places and also to the Council.

Should any person wish to make representations or object to the Council's intention to make the parking order then he/she must do so in writing, giving reason or reasons for objecting, to the Head of Legal Services, Council Offices, Stryd y Jêl, Caernarfon, Gwynedd LL55 1SH or by sending an e mail to timgwinyddolcyfreithiol@gwynedd.llyw.cymru and quoting reference 2442521.drj by no later than 26th January 2026
