MAES PARCIO NEWYDD TALU AC ARDDANGOS (GAN GYNNWYS
DARPARIAETH O BARCIO DROS NOS) AR “Y GLYN”, LLANBERIS.

Ar 12fed o Orffennaf 2023 fe wnaeth Cyngor Gwynedd (y Cyngor) (yr awdurdod sy'n gwneud y gorchmynion) y Gorchmynion uchod a thrwy ymarfer ei bwerau o dan y Ddeddf Rheoli Traffig y Ffyrdd 1984, fel y newidiwyd a phob pŵer galluogi arall ac ar ôl ymgynghori gyda Phrif Swyddog yr Heddlu yn unol â Rhan III o Atodlen 9 o Ddeddf Rheoli Trafnidiaeth Ffyrdd 1994

Mi fydd y tri gorchmyn yn dod yn weithredol ar 20fed o Orffennaf 2023, ac effaith y tri Gorchmyn uchod yw galluogi'r Cyngor i ddarparu Mannau Parcio Penodedig yn y meysydd parcio isod fel y bydd cerbydau yn cael parcio dros nos arnynt. Dim ond cerbydau sydd wedi cael eu gwneud er pwrpas aros dros nos neu rhai sydd wedi cael eu haddasu i'r pwrpas fydd yn cael aros dros nos. Ffi parcio'r noson fydd £15:00, ac fe fydd y cerbyd yn cael bod ar y Man Parcio Penodedig rhwng 4:00 yr hwyr ac 10.00 y bore canlynol. Cyfyngir yr arhosid at ddwy noson o'r bron, a ni chaniateir i'r cerbyd ddychwelyd i'r un Maes Parcio o fewn dwy noson o hynny.

Y meysydd parcio sydd wedi eu cynnwys yn y tair gorchmyn yw:
Maes Parcio Yr Hen Safle Shell, Caernarfon (ac a leolir rhwng Stofa Morrisons a'r Fenai);
Maes Parcio "Y Maes", Cricieth (ac a leolir rhwng Y Stryd Fawr a'r rheilffordd); a
Maes Parcio Ffordd y Gogledd, Pwllheli (ac a lleolir rhwng y rheilffordd a'r Marina); a hefyd
Maes Parcio "Y Glyn", Llanberis (ac a leolir ger Y Lagŵn ar lan Llyn Padarn).

Maes Parcio'r "Glyn": Dyma'r unig Faes Parcio Talu ac Arddangos Newydd, ac a fydd hefyd yn darparu aros dros nos.

Ynglŷn â'r cyfnod parcio tu allan i oriau parcio dros nos, mi fydd y cyfnod o godi tal yn rhedeg o Ddydd Llun i Ddydd Sul ac am 24 awr y dydd, ac yn gyfyngedig i gerbydau ysgafn yn unig. Codir ffi fel a ganlyn: hyd at 2 awr £2:00; hyd at 8 awr £6:00.

Maes Parcio Ffordd Y Gogledd, Pwllheli: maes parcio newydd arall fydd hwn, ond ni fydd yn Faes Parcio Talu ac Arddangos, a chodir ffi yn unig i'r rhai fydd yn aros dros nos (sef rhwng 4:00 yr hwyr a 10:00 y bore canlynol), rhwng Dydd Llun hyd Ddydd Sul ac i gerbydau ysgafn ond yn unig i'r rhai sydd wedi cael eu gwneud neu eu haddasu yn bwrpasol i aros dros nos.

Yr Hen Safle Shell, Caernarfon (1) a'r Maes, Cricieth (2): Mi fydd y ddau faes parcio yma yn parhau i fod yn feysydd parcio Talu ac Arddangos, a hefyd o hyn allan ceir darpariaeth parcio dros nos hefyd.

Gellir archwilio'r tri gorchymyn fel y maent wedi eu selio, y cynlluniau a'r gorchmynion blaenorol, y Datganiad Cyfartaledd a hefyd Y Rhesymau Dros Wneud Y Gorchmynion (a'r prif reswm i bob un o'r pedwar Maes Parcio yw atal neu i liniaru tagfeydd traffig), a gellir archwilio wrth ymweld â safle we'r Cyngor ar dab Trigolion/Parcio, Ffyrdd a Theithio/Gorchmynion Rheoliadau Traffig, neu wneud cais unigol at Mrs Ceri Hughes Thomas ar y cyfeiriad e bost isod, neu yn rhad ac am ddim wrth ymweld yn ystod oriau busnes arferol y manau canlynol:

Siop Gwynedd, Swyddfeydd y Cyngor, Ffordd y Castell, Caernarfon; neu
Siop Gwynedd, Swyddfeydd y Cyngor, Ffordd y Cob, Pwllheli;
Llyfrgell Llanberis a Llyfrgell Cricieth.

Pe dymuna unrhyw berson gwestiynu dilysrwydd unrhyw un neu'r tair gorchymyn neu unrhyw ddarpariaeth ynddi ar y sail na wnaethpwyd y gorchymyn o fewn pwerau'r Ddeddf, neu na chydymffurfiwyd gyda phob gofyniad o'r Ddeddf neu unrhyw Reoliadau a wnaethpwyd dan y Ddeddf, fe all y person hwnnw, o fewn 6 wythnos o'r dyddiad y gwnaethpwyd y gorchymyn wneud cais i'r pwrpas i'r Uchel Lys.

NOTICE INTIMATING THAT GWYNEDD COUNCIL HAVE MADE S THE ABOVE
ORDERS IN ORDER TO PROVIDE OVERNIGHT PARKING ON DESIGNATED
PARKING PLACES AT TWO OF ITS CAR PARKS (AT THE FORMER SHELL SITE IN
CAERNARFON AND Y MAES, CRICIETH), AND ALSO TO CREATE A NEW CAR
PARK FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF OVERNIGHT PARKING (AT NORTH ROAD,
PWLLHELI), AND A NEW PAY AND DISPLAY CAR PARK (INCLUDING THE
PROVISION OF OVERNIGHT PARKING) AT"Y GLYN", LLANBERIS.

On 12th July 2023 Gwynedd Council (the Council) (the order making authority) have made the three Orders mentioned above in exercise of the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and of all other powers enabling them and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1994.

The three orders will become effective on 20th July 2023, and the effect of the above three Orders is to enable the Council to provide Designated Parking Places on the below mentioned car parks so that purpose-made vehicles, or suitably adapted vehicles, will be allowed to stay overnight thereon. The nightly charging fee will be £15:00, and the payment will allow the vehicle to remain in the Designated Parking Place between 4:00 in the afternoon and 10:00 am on the following morning. Vehicles will not be allowed to stay at the car park after the second consecutive night, and a vehicle will not be allowed to return to that car park until two nights thereafter.

The car parks that are subject to the three orders are:

The Former Shell Site, Caernarfon (located between Morrisons Store and Y Fenai);
"Y Maes" Car Park, Cricieth (located between the High Street and the railway line);
North Road Car Park, Pwllheli (located between the railway line and the Marina);
and also "Y Glyn" Car Park, Llanberis (located by "The Lagoons" on the shore of Llyn Padarn).

"Y Glyn" Car Park : This will be a newly-created Pay and Display car park, but will also provide for overnight parking. The charging regime for the non-overnight parking hours will be between Monday and Sunday and for a 24 hour period, and will only be applicable to light vehicles. The charging rates shall be: up to 2 hours £2:00; up to 8 hours £6:00.

The North Road Car Park, Pwllheli, This will be a newly- created car park will not be a Pay and Display Car Park, and will only provide overnight parking. There shall only be a charge for Overnight Parking between the hours of 4:00pm and 10:00am the following morning, Monday to Sunday and for light vehicles, that is those purpose-made or properly adapted vehicles for the purpose of overnight parking.

The former Shell Site, Caernarfon (1) and “Y Maes”, Cricieth (2),:These car parks will continue to be Pay and Display Car Parks but will now also now provide for overnight parking.

A copy of the three sealed orders, the plans, the earlier orders, Equality Statement and a Statement of Reasons for making the Orders (and the principal reason at all four car parks is to relieve and prevent congestion of traffic) can be seen by visiting the Council’s website at Residents/Parking Roads and Travel/ Traffic Regulation Orders, or by making a request for hard copies to Mrs Ceri Hughes Thomas on the below mentioned e mail address.

Also the documents will be available for public inspection free of charge during normal business hours at:

Siop Gwynedd, Council Offices, Castle Street, Caernarfon; or
Siop Gwynedd, Council Offices, Ffordd Y Cob, Pwllheli; or
Llanberis Library or Cricieth Library.

Should any person wish to question the validity of any one or all of the orders or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
