Fel sy'n hysbys, ym mis Mai eleni, gofynnodd llywodraethwyr Ysgol Bro Tryweryn ac Ysgol Ffridd y Llyn i Adran Addysg Cyngor Gwynedd gynnal ymgynghoriad ar sefydlu trefniant ffederasiwn rhwng yr ysgolion o fis Hydref 2017 ymlaen. Re: Decision on the proposal to federate Ysgol Bro Tryweryn and Ysgol Ffridd y Llyn

As you may be aware, in May this year, the governors of Ysgol Bro Tryweryn and Ysgol Ffridd y Llyn asked Gwynedd Council's Education Department to consult on establishing a federation arrangement between the two schools from October 2017 onwards. The statutory consultation was held with the governing bodies and school councils of both schools between 8 June and 6 July 2017.

Following full consideration of the responses received to the consultation, I wish to inform you that Gwynedd Council has decided to **approve** the proposal to federate Ysgol Bro Tryweryn and Ysgol Ffridd y Llyn by 30 October 2017.

The formal federation of both schools will entail closer collaboration through sharing a headteacher and a single governing body. In addition, federation also has several benefits, including stability in the schools future leadership and financial benefits for both schools as they share one headteacher and governing body. It will mean being able to co-ordinate the best use of school resources and budgets.

Entering a federation arrangement for both schools **will not** mean any significant changes for parents or children.

The federation between the two schools, 'Ffederasiwn Cysgod y Foel' will be implemented from **30 October 2017** onwards, with one Headteacher, namely Bethan Emrys Jones, responsible for leading Ysgol Bro Tryweryn and Ysgol Ffridd y Llyn.
