

## **Open Days**

3 open days were organized in Pwllheli, Dolgellau and Penrhyndeudraeth between the hours of 14:00 and 19:00 to give people the opportunity to discuss and present comments on the statutory consultation.

We took display boards with the latest plans of the new school, consultation documents and background packs to the 3 meetings.

### **07.07.14 – Pwllheli**

3 people attended the open day. All 3 were very supportive of the new school and understood the how locating it in Penrhyndeudraeth appeared fair to the 2 areas.

One parent who had a child in Ysgol Hafod Lon said that she truly looked forward to him receiving the opportunity to use the new facilities and partake in new activities when the new school opened.

No objections or worries about the proposal were received on the day.

### **08.07.14 – Dolgellau**

3 people came to the open day. All 3 were very happy with the plans and location of the school. It was also noted that it was a good idea to open the school for use by the wider community so that they could use the facilities like the hydrotherapy pool.

2 comments relevant to the consultation were received:

- a) Are the electric cables that are near the site likely to create problems, in particular affecting the local radio/phone network?
- b) Was the site of the old hospital over the road to Snowdonia Park considered as a possible location for the new school?

There were no other concerns or objections to the proposal on the day. 2 people took a copy of the consultation document to consider the proposal further.

### **09.07.14 – Penrhyndeudraeth**

9 people came to the open day. All who came said that they were very supportive of the new school. 2 had children in Ysgol Hafod Lon and declared that their lives would be transformed when the new school opened. There were also positive comments about the facilities and location of the new school.

There were no concerns or objections to the proposal on the day. 3 people took a copy of the consultation document to consider the proposal further.
